Option to have an academic concentration (may require a few additional courses in an alternative UNC MBA format, with nominal fee attached).








## CLASS TIMES

Classes meet Monday evenings (5:30–9:45 p.m.) during core classes. To complete elective courses, you will be required to attend classes on a few additional evenings, with weekend options available (nominal fee may apply). You also attend four immersion weekends over the 24-month program.

## CLASSROOM FACILITIES

You will attend classes at the McColl Building on the UNC campus in Chapel Hill.

## LEADERSHIP AND YOUR CAREER

You'll work through our process of learning, practice, feedback and reflection to become a leader who can initiate change and drive business strategy within your organization. Leadership and professional development courses are integrated into the core curriculum, with additional leadership elective courses, seminars and activities available.

Career management support includes individual coaching, workshops and seminars, alumni networking, campus events and access to online resources. UNC's Career Management team is dedicated to providing guidance customized to your career goals.

## LIFELONG LEARNING

Evening MBA alumni may return to take additional elective courses for a nominal fee.

## COST

The cost for the Evening MBA program beginning October 2013 is \$76,000. Cost includes tuition, texts, socials and orientation weekend accommodations. It does not cover accommodations for three additional immersion weekends.
