MBA Degree

Program Strengths

Experience Required

Five years minimum professional work experience, with eight preferred

Program Length

February 2013 to October 2014 (20 months)

Class Times

All day Friday and Saturday twice a month, plus one immersion week

Classroom Facilities

Rizzo Conference Center in Chapel Hill and the McColl building next to the Dean Smith Center on UNC's campus

Leadership Development — Leadership and communication skills courses and seminars are integrated into the core curriculum, with additional leadership elective courses available.
