

## Executive Development Scholarship Application

As a State University, the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill's Kenan-Flagler Business School is committed to assist leaders from public service, education, state and local government and private nonprofit organizations within the State of North Carolina. As part of this commitment, we offer one Executive Development scholarship per offering for each of our open enrollment programs. This scholarship provides a substantial reduction from the regular tuition. The amount varies by program and can be found on page two of this application.

### Scholarship Requirements

Scholarship recipients are required to pay a portion of the regular tuition fee to cover a portion of their program expenses. This fee is due at the time of acceptance. Travel costs are the responsibility of the recipient or the sponsoring organization.

Scholarship recipients who cancel or transfer less than four weeks prior to the start of the program, forfeit their scholarship fee. Applicants wishing to attend another session may reapply to scholarship assistance.
