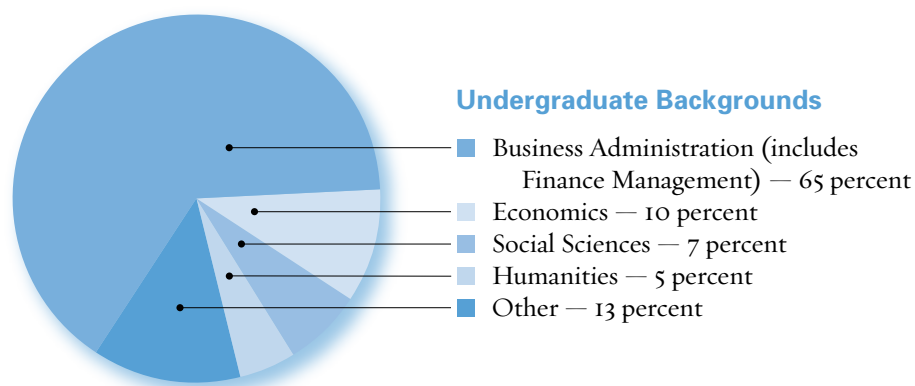

Student Profile and Employment Highlights

- Of the 120 May 2011 graduates, 115 were seeking full-time employment in the United States. 98.3 percent of U.S. citizens had obtained and accepted a full-time employment offer as of May 11, 2011.
- International students make up 7 percent of the Class of 2011.
- Gender ratio — females 39 percent, males 61 percent
- Average incoming GPA — 3.4
- Average incoming GMAT — 649
- 37 percent of MAC students who accepted full-time employment will be working in cities outside of North Carolina.
- The most popular cities for employment-bound MAC 2011 students are: Charlotte, 36.1 percent; Raleigh, 22.2 percent; New York, 11.1 percent; Washington, D.C., 7.4 percent; and Atlanta, 6.5 percent.
- 93.5 percent of the MAC class accepted employment in public accounting firms. 79.2 percent of that group are employed in Big 4 firms.
