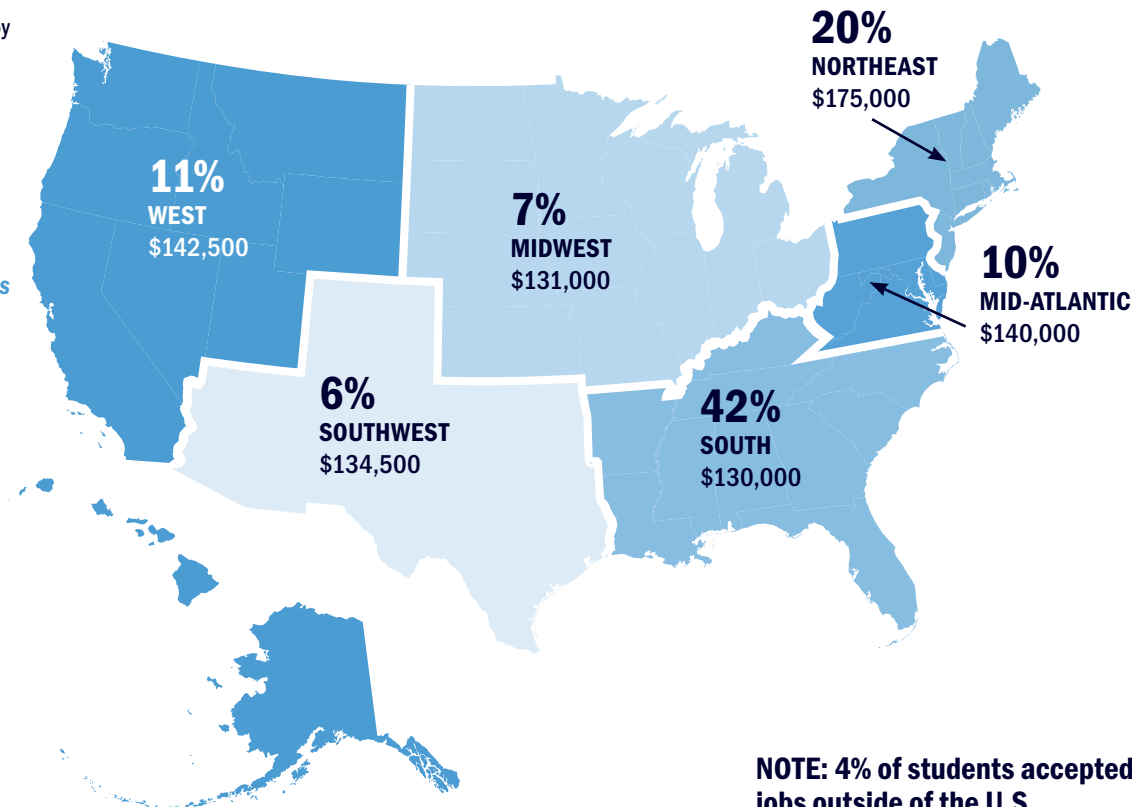


EMPLOYMENT BY REGION
